 - Neighbourhood Community Infrastructure Levy (NCIL) Ward NCIL Revenue Grant. Application made on 22nd Sept for 'roaming' Dr Bikes in Deptford.
- $\circ~$ Air Quality open discussion.
 - In the light of the Rosamund Kissi-Debrah settlement on government responsibility for air quality should we attempt a joint statement to LBL from ourselves and Climate Action Lewisham on the urgent need for Healthy Streets etc....

 - We're opposed to this scheme as it doesn't provide any protected space for cycling on a key radial route across Lewisham. We believe the council should be taking a holistic view of this route providing protected space for cycling and localised bus priority.
