Lower Road Safety Improvements

Lower Road cycleway scheme provides a segregated cycleway along the A200 Lower Road from Rotherhithe roundabout to Evelyn St in Lewisham. It is the last part of cycleway 4 to be built, which provides a dedicated cycleway from London Bridge to Greenwich.

The scheme has the following aims:

- Improve walking, cycling and wheeling
- Create safer, more accessible route for cyclists
- Provide a high-quality, two-way segregated cycle route between London Bridge and Greenwich
- Encourage people to shop local to help businesses and reduce car use

Following the 12-month construction, the cycleway was officially opened to the public on 4 March 2024.

Cycleway 4 at Surrey Quays - act now and support retention of the scheme

Southwark's monitoring shows the route has been incredibly successful with a whopping 57% increase in cycling since spring 2023!
