Key cycle track opens in Deptford



After almost a year of construction work, the much anticipated protected cycle track on Deptford Church Street (DCS) opened in mid-December. In celebration, Mayor Dacres, Deputy Mayor Krupski, Will Norman (London Walking and Cycling Commissioner), Lewisham Cyclists and Project Team

members recently attended a ride-over and photo call along the route:

The track, designated part of Cycleway 18 (C18), now links Cycleway 4 (Tower Bridge - Greenwich) with Deptford Bridge (Waterlink Way) for routes to Lewisham and beyond.

This useful [London Cycle Routes video](#) shows how to utilise C18 for your ride to the West End.

The new track also links to Cycleway 10, a popular route towards Bermondsey. You told us of some signage confusion where these cross and we've "snagged" this with Lewisham Council.

We campaigned for this DCS track for a number of years once it became clear that half the road would be closed to traffic for Thames Tideway sewer construction works. Massive thanks to Lewisham Council for recognising this opportunity for active travel improvements, pulling together the funding and the enthusiastic team to deliver the project.

This is also the first completed section of the proposed Lewisham Spine, a safe active travel route from Deptford to Downham via Lewisham and Catford. We will now campaign to extend the Spine to central Lewisham via Brookmill Road, and further along the A21 to Catford, a route which is already popular with people on cycles.



Waterlink Way Bridge replacement

After many years of campaigning, the old wooden bridge over the River Pool on the Waterlink Way (WW) is being replaced with a new structure. The old bridge had subsided and was becoming hazardous and difficult to ride over as well as being too narrow for pedestrians and cyclists to share the space comfortably.

Work is expected to take 12 weeks with a diversionary route being signed from February along Perry Hill and Catford Hill then back onto WW via the small park on Catford Hill to regain the Catford Bridge underpass near Halfords.



New 'Tiger' crossing on Pagnell Street

Last month's new crossings have now been supplemented with another cycle-friendly tiger crossing at Pagnell Street improving safety for all users between Fordham Park and New Cross Station. This is a very busy shared active travel route and Pagnell Street is often busy with commuter traffic.



Cycleway 10 reopens at Millwall

Cycleway 10 to the rear of the Millwall stadium is now fully open again following a lengthy programme of utility works.

Unfortunately since it reopened we've seen illegal car parking along the shared track in Senegal Road which makes passing tricky for people on cycles. The Council is aware but if you encounter this, please take a photo and report via the Love Clean Streets mobile app or [website](#).
