Annual Meeting - Save the Date - Wednesday 14th October 6:30pm

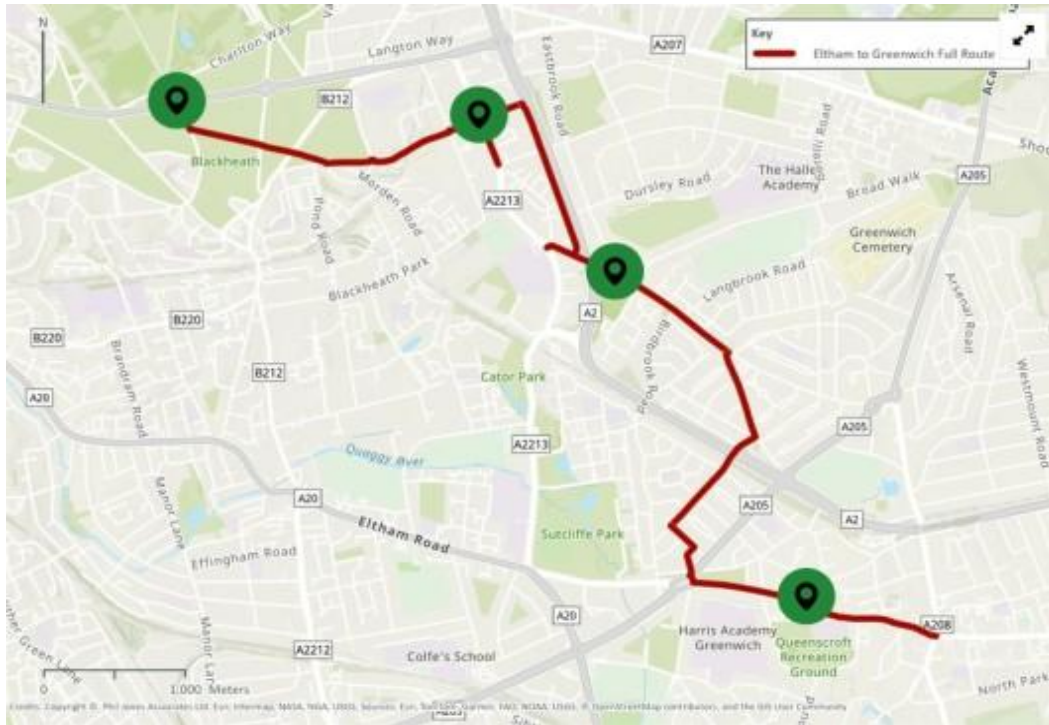

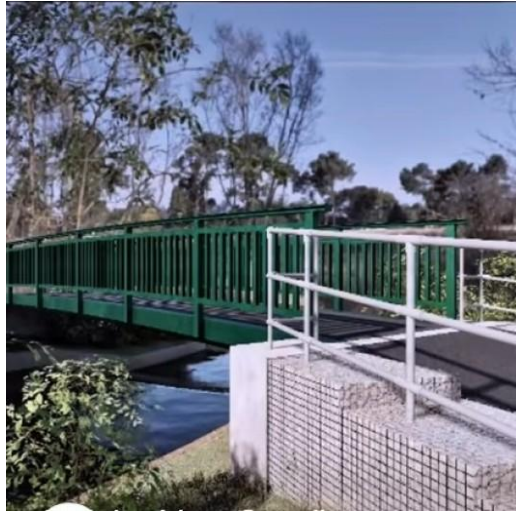
Support the consultation on RBG Eltham to Greenwich cycle route proposals

Waterlink Way Bridge replacement - latest update

After many years of campaigning, the old wooden bridge over the River Pool on the Waterlink Way is being replaced with a new structure. Sadly the project has been significantly delayed. The latest update from the Council on 2nd September was:

"During the works, a damaged Thames Water pipe was discovered. While this was not caused by the bridge project, it must be repaired before work can continue safely.

As a result, the project programme has been delayed, and we are now aiming to restart works before the end of September and reopen the new bridge in November."



New cycle crossing of Old Kent Road at Ilderton Road

This safe cycle crossing across Old Kent Road on Cycleway 62 (Peckham to Rotherhithe) is now open. This Cycleway will dip into the north edge of Lewisham but we haven't heard when the rest of it is planned to be constructed.
